### **Panels fixed but removable – easily done with item's locking multiblock!**

Whether it is a maintenance hatch, lamp cover or protective housings made removable for cleaning: the locking multiblock made by item now offers a new component in its versatile MB Building Kit System which provides just this functionality of restricted access.

The panel element is attached using tenons which are locked in place by a quarter-turn in the locking multiblock. The various designs of tenon, allowing either a toggle or a coin-slot operation made of die-cast zinc or plastic, allow the designer to decide which kind of opening mechanism to fit depending on frequency.

The locking spring integrated in the multiblock ensures the tenon locks securely in place and prevent rattles in the panel elements: the 90° catch keeps the spring tensioned and maintains a steady contact pressure.

Releasing the multiblock is just as simple - the tenon can be removed and the panel extracted. This allows controlled access to the interior which can then easily be closed off again.
