Spotlight 35 W is available with immediate effect to complement the MB Building Kit System. This represents an innovative industrial-quality light in a sturdy, spray-protected aluminium housing which is, at the same time, attractive and convenient.

The bulb is protected by a hardened glass disk, the on/off switch is incorporated in the housing and the integrated item MB Building Kit System Groove 8 enables the Spotlight to be attached to machines, workplaces and housings at virtually any conceivable position and angle.

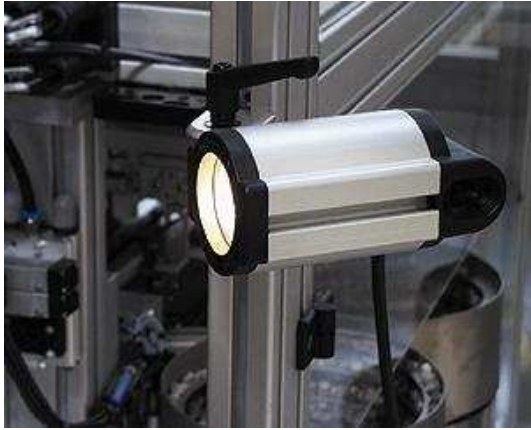
Thanks to its IP 67 rating, the safe 12 V power requirement and the cool-air channels integrated in the housing which keep the surface temperature down to an acceptable level, the lamp can be considered a highly safe additional element.

And, as usual, it wouldn't be item if there wasn't a system to it. To match the Spotlights, there are all the necessary accessories, from electronic transformers - for up to three Spotlights - to distributor boxes and connecting cables. Spotlight 35W is also available with a 400 mm flexible tubular arm. In this way, the user can direct the light more efficiently on to the work in hand.
